Press Release- In-Custody Death

February 11, 2022

On Thursday, February 10, 2022 at 11:12pm, Door County Jail deputies observed an inmate who appeared to be unresponsive. They checked on the subject and found that he did not have a pulse and was not breathing. Deputies then began life-saving measures. Paramedics from the Door County Emergency Services, first responders from the Sturgeon Bay Fire Department and officers from the Sturgeon Bay Police Department and Door County Sheriff's Office- Patrol Division responded to the jail. Lifesaving measures continued but were not successful and the subject was pronounced deceased.

The Door County Sheriff's Office has requested that the Brown County Sheriff's Office investigate the death. The Brown County Medical Examiner has scheduled an autopsy for Monday, February 14, 2022.

The victim was a 54 year-old Sturgeon Bay man who was in jail on a probation hold. His name is not being released pending notification of the next-of-kin.

No further information is being released at this time as this incident remains under investigation.
